Annual Report for the Year 2010-11

Dear Members,

On behalf of CSI, Delhi Chapter, it is my proud privilege to welcome you all in the Annual General Body Meeting (AGM) of CSI, Delhi Chapter. I take this opportunity to present to this August House, the Annual Report highlighting the activities conducted during the year 2010-11.

Major achievement during the year 2010-11 are as under:

1. A One Day National Conference on "ICT : An Engine for Inclusive Social Growth" was organized on 28.08.2010 at Constitution Club of India, Rafi Marg. This Conference was Inaugurated by Dr. B.K. Gairola, DG, NIC and Prof. K.K. Agarwal, Ex-VC-GGSIPU and Past President, CSI. This conference was well attended by approx 95 Delegates from various Organizations, Industries and Academia. Eminent Speaker who delivered the lectures on the theme were from the reputed Organizations like C-DOT, IIT-D, GE-Health etc; This Conference was Sponsored by various ICT based vendors for making the Event self sufficient and given surplus to the CSI.

The conference was concluded by a Panel Discussion on the same theme, presided by Dr. Mahesh Chandra, DDG, NIC and the other eminent panelist were Ms. Rama Vedashree, VP, NASSCOM, Shri Pradeep Gupta, CEO & MD, Cyber Media and Prof. P.S. Grover, DG, GTBIIT.

2. One Day National Summit on 'Cloud Computing & Green IT Technologies' was organized on 10.12.2010 at Constitution Club of India, Rafi Marg. This Event was Inaugurated by Prof. S.V. Raghavan, Special Secretary, O/o The Principal Scientific Advisor to the Prime Minister. The other Guest of Honors were Maj. Gen Mahasley, Army-HQ, Shri Onkar Rai, DG, STPI, Shri S.R. Roy, ED, NHPC, Dr. Rattan K. Datta, Past-President, CSI. The Summit was very well attended by approx. 50 Delegates. Mr. Daman Dev Sood, Mr. Prashanto K. Roy were among the various eminent Speakers. This Summit was supported by various IT Companies for making the event successful and also given surplus to the CSI.

3. One Day National Symposium on 'Software 2.0 Emerging Competencies' was organized on 06.01.2011 at India International Centre, Lodhi Road with the support of Division-II, Chaired by Dr. T.V. Gopal. This event was inaugurated by Shri S.P.Vaid, IPS and IG (Trg.), BPR&D. Dr.T.V. Gopal and Mr. Gautam Shroff were among the various eminent Speakers of the Day. The event was very well attended by IT Professionals from various Organizations. The prospective Sponsors also given financial support to this event which resulted the surplus to the CSI.

4. An Evening Lecture was delivered by Mr. Leon Strous, President, IFIP on 06.01.2011 from 6.00 PM at IIC, Lodhi Road, New Delhi. The topic of the lecture was on Information Security. This event was presided by Mr. Lalit Sawhney, Past President, CSI. This lecture was very well attended by CSI Members.

5. Based on the advice of President, CSI and other senior members, Delhi Chapter being the mother in Delhi/NCR Region, may financially assist to all its Student Branches in the region, once in a year for promoting the IT Welfare activities among the Students. Based on this feeling, CSI, Delhi Chapter provided the support to the following Student Branches:

5.1 Alwar Institute of Engineering & Technology (AIET):

Student Branch at AIET, Alwar was inaugurated on 24.04.2010 by Delhi Chapter on behalf of Prof. P. Thirumurthy, President, CSI. Since then, Student Branch of AIET is the part of Delhi Chapter instead of Udaipur (Rajasthan).

5.2 Kamrah Institute of Information Technology (KIIT):

CSI Student Branch, KIIT successfully organized a three days conference on "Intelligent Systems & Knowledge Web" from 22nd to 24th July, 2010 at KIIT, Gurgaon.
